Merck*, which had been scheduled for trial back in March 2014, was postponed for reasons have to do with the trial court Judge, Carol Higbee, being elevated to a New Jersey appellate court position on short notice. It is uncertain at the present time when the *Unanski* case will be rescheduled for trial.
