Pfizer to Pay \$60 Million to Settle Foreign Bribery Charges

Pfizer has agreed to pay \$60 million to settle charges that it violated the <u>Foreign Corrupt</u> <u>Practices Act</u>. As this case highlights, public companies continue to face tough scrutiny from the federal government over their dealings overseas.

The Securities and Exchange Commission alleged subsidiaries of Pfizer paid bribes to foreign government officials to increase sales and secure regulatory approvals. The violations took place in Bulgaria, China, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Italy, Kazakhstan, Russia and Serbia. The government did not allege that anyone at the company's corporate headquarters knew of the conduct in question, which it voluntarily reported to the government.

Nonetheless, Pfizer will pay \$5 million to settle the SEC charges. The drug-maker also entered into a deferred prosecution agreement with the Department of Justice, agreeing to pay a \$15 million penalty.

As we have previously discussed on this Arizona white-collar crime blog, the SEC and DOJ are jointly responsible for enforcing the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA). The SEC brings civil enforcement actions, while the DOJ criminally prosecutes violators.

Both agencies have stepped up enforcement in recent years, with varying levels of success. While the DOJ has had trouble making charges stick in several high-profile cases, the agencies have collectively levied more than \$1.6 *billion* in criminal and civil fines, penalties, interest, and disgorgement.
