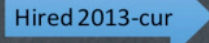

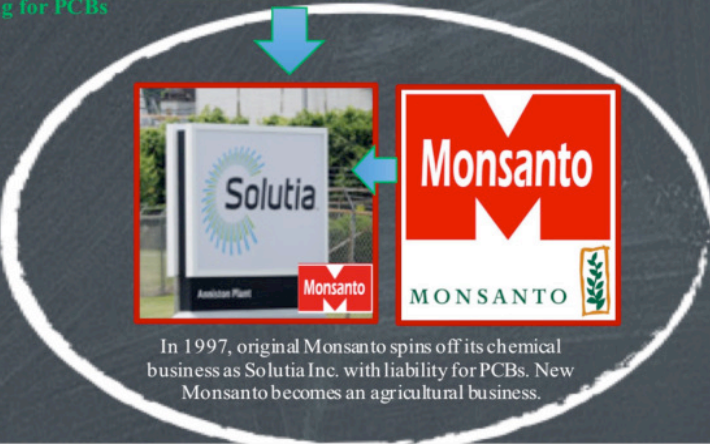

2003-2008 Pillsbury represents Solutia for PCB liability bankruptcy

*SMMUSD Board Member Lieberman's husband's, law partner worked for Pillsbury. In 2013, SMMUSD hired Pillsbury to avoid PCB regulation. Pillsbury also worked for Monsanto's spinoff Solutia in a PCB liability bankruptcy case. SMMUSD has paid \$2 million to Pillsbury and spent \$5 million more on PR and consultants to avoid testing caulk for PCBs. When SMMUSD was presented with an option by other lawyers to sue Monsanto for PCB liability, SMMUSD passed and instead spent \$7 million to avoid PCBs testing leaving kids at risk. Could Pillsbury's relationship with Solutia have influenced that decision?



In 1997, original Monsanto spins off its chemical business as Solutia Inc. with liability for PCBs. New Monsanto becomes an agricultural business.
