This matter having come before this Court on Plaintiff Marc Dorsey’s (“Plaintiff”) motion for a preliminary injunction against Defendants Black Pearl Books, Inc. and Felicia Hurst (collectively, “Defendants”); and it appearing that this Court reviewed the parties’ written submissions and oral argument; and for the reasons set forth in the accompanying Opinion, and good cause appearing,

IT IS on this 14th day of November, 2006,

ORDERED that Plaintiff’s motion for a preliminary injunction (Docket Entry No. 5) is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants are hereby enjoined from continuing to publish and distribute or otherwise exploit the book Legit Baller in its current form, or otherwise publish, distribute, or exploit any other books or advertising or promotional materials that contain Plaintiff’s likeness; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants recall all copies of Legit Baller from bookstores and other

commercial and retail outlets throughout the United States, to which it has been distributed; and
it is further

ORDERED that Plaintiff post a bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 in connection with his
request for a preliminary injunction; and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served on the parties within seven (7) days of the
entry of this Order.
