On Wednesday, December 15, 2010, the Michigan Supreme Court denied a motion filed by a prisoner-apellant to waive the filing fee in the case of Hudson v. Lorence, Case No. 142275. The order explained that MCL 600.2963 requires a prisoner pursuing a civil action be liable for filing fees. The prisoner-appellant will be eligible for a payment plan, but only if the pleadings are re-filed within 21 days along with a partial filing fee of \$45.00.
