

China Investment Catalogue to be revised

Lawviewer.com April 11, 2011- Planned revisions to the Catalogue Guiding Foreign Investment in Industry listed foreign investment released by China government recently reflect some encourage areas related to high-tech and new developing industries, such as productions on environmental protection. There is a trend that some over-invested industries like real estate and automobile production will be removed from encourage area or even be banned.

In the revision, China is to ban foreign investment in the construction of villas, apparently part of government efforts to cool the real estate market, as Reuters reported.

The new revision is expected to have further adaption after public feedback, and maybe take into effective in early June or July. It is advisable for foreign investors to have an early insight into this new Investment Catalogue.
