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Re: OMB Releases Spring 2019 Unified Agenda of Regulatory Actions

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) recently released the Spring 2019 Unified Agenda of Regulatory Actions, which outlines the rulemaking actions currently under development in each federal agency. This memorandum summarizes the major actions that may be of particular interest to the food industry that are being planned by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA's) Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), Food and Nutrition Service (FNS), and Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS). After highlighting the most significant priorities, we provide charts for each agency that provide additional details on their plans. More information can be found by clicking on the blue link next to each item, which will take you to a specific page about each agenda item on OMB's website.

We want to caution that the dates included in the Unified Agenda are not commitments to act on or by the date shown and simply indicate the agencies' aspirations. Rather than focusing on projected dates, the Unified Agenda is a valuable tool to identify the substantive issues the agencies consider to be priorities for rulemaking.

FDA's current priorities include the following:

- FDA has completed the seven major rulemakings under the FDA Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) and the agency has turned its efforts to more discrete actions to fine tune the regulations. FDA's agenda for future FSMA-related rulemakings includes:
 - . Streamlining the written assurance requirements that apply when a manufacturer/processor or importer of food identifies a hazard requiring a preventive control, but does not control the hazard (e.g., 21 CFR § 117.136) (May 2019). FDA plans to conduct parallel rulemakings for the Preventive Controls for Human Food, Preventive Controls for Animal Food, and Foreign Supplier Verification Programs rules, but the Unified Agenda does not include similar plans for the Produce Safety rule:
 - 2. Clarifying changes to the food facility registration requirements, including revising the definition of "farm" (November 2019);

- 3. Proposing a regulation on laboratory accreditation, which will enable FDA to recognize accreditation bodies that will accredit laboratories performing analyses of food under certain circumstances (May 2019); and
- 4. Proposing a regulation to revise certain requirements that currently apply to produce that satisfies criteria for an exemption from the Produce Safety rule because that produce will receive commercial processing to adequately reduce the presence of microorganisms of public health significance (October 2019).
- FDA plans to issue a proposed rule to update the agency's regulations to remove all mention of partially hydrogenated oils (PHOs) and to revoke all prior sanctioned uses. This action follows FDA's declaratory order in June 2015 announcing the agency's determination that there no longer is a consensus among qualified experts that PHOs are Generally Recognized as Safe (GRAS) for any use in human food and FDA's denial of a food additive petition in May 2018 requesting that the regulations be amended to provide for the safe use of PHOs in certain food applications (November 2019).
- FDA will issue a proposed rule to update the definition for the implied nutrient content claim "healthy" to be consistent with current nutrition science and federal dietary guidelines (May 2019).
- FDA also plans to propose a rule to add a second methodology for the analysis of sulfites in foods, which FDA states will improve the speed and efficiency in FDA testing for sulfites in food for enforcement activities (May 2019).
- FDA will reopen the comment period for a proposed rule relating to modernizing food standards of identity (September 2019). The agency also will promulgate proposed rules to revoke the current standards of identity for French dressing and frozen cherry pie (November and December 2019). FDA plans to finalize a rule amending the standard for yogurt and revoking the standards for lowfat and nonfat yogurt (September 2019).
- FDA will issue a final rule on fluoride levels in bottled water (April 2020). The comment period for the proposed rule ended earlier this month. The proposed rule revises the quality standard for bottled water to specify that bottled water to which fluoride is added by the manufacturer may not contain fluoride that exceeds 0.7 milligrams per liter (mg/L).
- FDA plans on finalizing several other proposed regulations, including:
 - 1. An amendment to FDA's regulation authorizing the use of health claims regarding the relationship between soy protein and coronary heart disease (December 2019); and
 - 2. A rule that would establish requirements concerning "gluten-free" labeling for foods that are fermented or hydrolyzed or that contain fermented or hydrolyzed ingredients (September 2019).
- FDA intends to finalize its proposed rule to amend its regulations on the type size requirement for calorie declarations for Front of Pack (FOP) labeling in glass front vending machines (October 2019).

The priorities for agencies within USDA include the following:

- FSIS currently is finalizing initiatives to modernize inspection systems and to eliminate or streamline regulations. FSIS plans to finalize a proposal to modernize swine slaughter inspection (July 2019), and it intends to finalize a rule to transition egg products manufacturing from a "command and control" system to a Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) program (August 2019). The swine slaughter modernization rule follows on the Agency's modernized poultry slaughter inspection rule from several years ago.
- FSIS will issue a proposed rule expanding the categories of meat and poultry products that can be approved through the generic labeling approval process. FSIS is proposing to make these changes by revising its labeling regulations in 9 CFR Part 412. (October 2019).
- FSIS will issue a proposed rule amending the Federal meat inspection regulations to clarify
 that official establishments that transport adulterated or misbranded product under
 establishment or FSIS controls to another official establishment for appropriate disposition
 are not required to notify or obtain permission from FSIS prior to transporting the product
 (October 2019).
- FSIS pushed back its estimate for issuing a final rule that would allow China to export to the U.S. poultry products from birds slaughtered in China from October 2018 to May 2019.
 Currently, China only may export to the U.S. poultry products processed in China but slaughtered in the U.S. or other eligible countries.
- FSIS's proposed nutrition labeling update, which in large part would harmonize FSIS nutrition labeling regulations with FDA's updated regulations, remains as a "long term action," which indicates FSIS is unlikely to prioritize finalizing the changes this fiscal year. FSIS currently is letting companies follow either the existing FSIS nutrition labeling rules or the updated FDA nutrition labeling rules.
- FSIS plans to propose rules establishing limitations on the time periods in which
 establishments may appeal inspectional decisions. Currently, FSIS encourages timely
 appeals but does not have regulations limiting when appeals may be made. (October 2019).
- AMS plans to publish an interim final rule initiating a new part 990 establishing rules and regulations for a domestic hemp production program (August 2019). This action is required to implement provisions of the 2018 Farm Bill.
- AMS is proposing to revise its regulations under the Packers and Stockyards Act (P&S Act)
 to specify criteria the Secretary could consider in determining whether conduct or action by
 packers, swine contractors, or live poultry dealers constitutes an undue or unreasonable
 preference or advantage and a violation of the P&S Act (June 2019). This proposal is part of
 a long-running and contentious rulemaking effort initiated in response to the 2008 Farm Bill.

 APHIS is proposing to revise its regulations regarding the importation, interstate movement, and environmental release of certain genetically engineered organisms in order to update the regulations in response to advances in genetic engineering and APHIS' understanding of the plant health risk posed by genetically engineered organisms to reduce the burden for regulated entities whose organisms pose no plant health risks (April 2019).
