Interestingly, the CPSC did not label the issuance of these repair kits as a product recall, despite their previous practice of doing so in a similar situation involving furniture. The press, for their part, appear to be still calling this a recall. Whether the CPSC will continue to avoid labeling such situations as a recall is not yet clear, but such a practice would be beneficial for client relations and for clarity's sake.

Dehumidifier Press Release	Appliance	Knowing failure to report a defect and an unreasonable risk of serious injury with several models of dehumidifiers. The failure to report began in 2003 when the company began receiving reports that the dehumidifiers overheated, smoked, melted or caught fire. By the time the products were recalled in 2012, there were multiple instances of smoke inhalation and more than \$7 million in property damage.	\$1.825 million
