Non-Profits - Pay Attention - You Could Lose Your Tax Exempt Status On October 15

Calling all non-profits - Act NOW or lose your tax exempt status. The bad news - any non-profit that has not filed its income tax return Form 990-N by October 15, 2010 will lose its tax exempt status and need to reapply.

The good news - you still have time to fix the problem. You can file the <u>Form 990-N</u> electronically for tax years 2007, 2008 and 2009 on or before <u>October 15, 2010</u> and keep your tax exempt status. You must file for all 3 years if you have been in existence that long and this offer expires on the 15th.
