

## Revised FCC Form 499-A Released To Include Non-Interconnected VolP Providers; FCC Registration Required By December 31

The FCC has posted its revised Form 499-A to include "non-interconnected VoIP providers" as a category of required filing entities. As we discussed <u>previously</u>, new FCC rules now require certain non-interconnected VoIP providers (including one-way services) to (1) register with the FCC by December 31, 2011, and (2) report revenues to the FCC by April 1 each year for purposes of contributing to the federal TRS fund.
