<u>ORDER</u>

No party, attorney, employee, representative or agent of any party or attorney shall contact, communicate with or interview any petit juror concerning the voir dire, deliberations, verdict or any other matter related to this trial except upon leave of Court which shall be granted only upon the showing of good cause. This Order means that the Court shall have continuing supervision over communications with jurors, **even after a trial has been completed**.

This Order however, does not preclude or prevent post-trial contact with jurors by any member of the media, assuming the juror(s) is willing. Any violation of this Order will be treated as a contempt of Court and will be punished accordingly.

It is further **ORDERED** that the jury box, jury room, the rest rooms which are next to the jury room and the hallway that connects jury room 6600 and jury room 6500 are "OFF LIMITS" to all persons connected with this trial and anyone working on their behalf. It is a violation of this Order as well as the criminal laws of the State of Alabama to listen or attempt to listen to a jury's deliberations. No person connected with this trial or anyone working on their behalf may enter or be in the above described areas for any purpose whatsoever even after completion of the trial. This includes for the purpose of picking up of your exhibits, viewing of notes or "trash" in the jury room or for any purpose without express approval from the Court given "on the record". The Court also considers any effort to gather trash, notes or garbage, in any manner, which may have originated from the jury or the Court to be a grave violation of this Order.

Jurors should bring to the attention of the Judge any violation of this Order by calling Judge Joseph S. Johnston or his Criminal Coordinator, Theresa Turner, at 574-8686.
