- Running a stop sign or traffic light;
- Swerving between traffic lanes; or
- Failing to use a turn signal.

There are other reasons aside from driving under the influence that can cause these situations to occur. As a result, anyone who believes that they have been wrongfully accused of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol in Scottsdale, AZ, should contact a DUI attorney right away.
