USPTO Begins Accepting International Design Applications

On May 13, 2015, the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) will begin accepting U.S. design patent applications under the Hague Agreement. This agreement allows U.S. applicants to file up to 100 designs in over 64 member countries that are party to the Hague Agreement by filing a single International Design Application ("IDA") with the USPTO. Among the current members are Japan, South Korea, and the EU.

As first reported in our December 2013 newsletter, the first new generic top-level domains (gTLDs, the group of letters after the "dot" in a domain name) have launched their "Sunrise" registration periods.
