Armed Robbery in Arizona

Armed robbery is taken very seriously in the state of Arizona, as it is a <u>class 2 felony</u> and can carry a prison sentence of 7 to 21 years. Armed robbery differs from robbery in the fact that the perpetrator is confronting the victim with a deadly weapon. Below is the Arizona definition of armed robbery.

A.R.S. § 13-1904 Armed Robbery

A. A person commits armed robbery if, in the course of committing robbery as defined in <u>section 13-1902</u>, such person or an accomplice:

- 1. Is armed with a deadly weapon or a simulated deadly weapon, or
- 2. Uses or threatens to use a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument or a simulated deadly weapon.
- B. Armed robbery is a <u>class 2 felony</u>.
